Birddrops Aloft After Snag of Leathermen and Fall of Puke

Birddrops Aeronautics School attained the number one ranking for the first time in SCAB history on the last week of the 1996 season, when Puke fell to Our Lady. The Ragin' Roosters were the only team in the SCAB to finish undefeated and they won the Little 10 Conference championship, both firsts for them. Birddrops coach Rusty Pipes, who was the school's first quarterback, was named SCAB Coach of the Year. Pre-season number one DeSade S&M was dumped by Marxist Orthodox in the sixth week. The MO Big Red had beaten Northwestsoutheastern the previous week and stunned everyone by leading the Pack to the end, and with only one loss -- to Cretin -- and the decision over DeSade, gaining the Punch Bowl prize. Defending SCAB champion Our Lady was upset by conference foe Puerto Rico in New York, but then upended Puke for Fish Bowl rights. Besides Marxist Orthodox, other surprises were Bunyan, whom running back Igor Beaver led to the brink of a conference championship in a resurgence that came earlier than expected, and Whooperville A&M, which overachieved for new coach Pervis Elsley. Northwestsoutheastern remained a contender despite graduation woes, making the SCAB tournament for a record 15th time, but also, by doing so, setting the new record for consecutive tournament appearances at 12. Mountain Valley held the previous record. Tab Lloyd became the third Puke quarterback to win the Demetrius Award, the fourth for the school since Lance Boils won two of them. He had 159 net completions, passed for 48 TDs and scored 10 more on his own, the 58 TDs accounted for breaking the record of 50 set by South Paw's Marion Havkitz in 1986. Ernesto Hornets of State Pen. won the rushing title on the last week of the season, passing Igor Beaver who had lead the whole season. Freshman receiver Mel Stripper of Our Lady lead the SCAB with 19 TDs.
